



# CODE OF CONDUCT

Members, guests, visitors, employees and contractors are all reminded that an acceptable standard of behaviour must be maintained at all times whilst in the Estate. The Association reserves the right to take immediate steps in its absolute discretion against any person that contravenes the Rules and/or Code of the Estate.

## On The Estate

- All entrants to the Estate are reminded to be considerate of other residents and not to engage in behaviour that is to the detriment of residents, the estate, its employees or any other person.
- Communal areas are to be accessible and for the orderly enjoyment of everyone.
- Please observe and maintain the Rules of the Estate.
- Abusive or disrespectful behaviour of any kind towards the Association staff is unacceptable.
- Speed limits on the Estate and other road traffic ordinances must be strictly adhered to.
- Fauna and Flora on the estate may not be interfered with or damaged.

## On The Course

- All golfers must adhere to the local rules of the Club.
- Follow established golf etiquette at all times respecting the golf course, its facilities and fellow golfers.
- Treat the pro shop staff and course marshals with respect and obey their requests.
- Display due consideration during play for residents and their safety and property.

## In The Clubhouse

- Right of Admission is reserved by the Association.
- Acceptable dress code must be adhered to at all times.
- No pets allowed.
- Patrons are reminded not to engage in any form of discrimination or harassment towards any member of staff or other patrons.
- The use of loud, foul or abusive language has no place in the clubhouse and any person heard using unacceptable or offensive language will be asked to leave the premises.
- Alcohol will only be served to patrons over the age of 18 years and must be used responsibly.
- Smoking is only allowed in the designated smoking areas.
