



# Fishing Club Rules

as amended on 11 May 2015



The Fishing Club rules shall always comply with and be subject to the Rules of the Silver Lakes Homeowners Association NPC ("Association"), and in the event of any conflict between the Fishing Club rules and the rules of the Association, the rules of the latter shall prevail.

1. Only residents and/or members of the Golf Club may become members of the Fishing Club.
2. Only paid up members of the Fishing Club will be allowed to fish on the Estate.
3. Members must carry membership cards with them when fishing and produce them on request.
4. If members wish to invite visitors to fish, the visitor must be accompanied by a card-carrying member at all times.
5. Fishing is only allowed in the following demarcated areas:
  - a. On the dam wall, to the right of the 17th fairway, approximately 30 metres from the 14th green, to the end of the wall, opposite the 12th green;
  - b. A small (10 - 15 metres) area **behind** the 10th green;
  - c. A small area (10 - 15 metres) to the right of the bridge leading to the 9th green;
  - d. A 50 metre strip on the the bank of the dam between the 5th and 7th green, opposite the 7th green; and
  - e. The dam in the nature reserve area (the grass embankment on the South east corner of the dam, near the small inlet)
6. Fishing is only permitted between 7:30 until 19:30, Monday to Sunday (including public holidays).
7. All fish, unless hurt, **must be released**.
8. No person is allowed on the greens or in the bunkers while fishing.
9. The lighting of fires, including gas braai's, will not be allowed while fishing.
10. No camping, overnight camping and/or tents allowed. Only beach umbrellas and open sided gazebo's will be allowed while fishing.
11. No cars are allowed on the golf course.
12. Golf carts are allowed, provided they stick to the rules for golf carts as prescribed by the Association.
13. No boating or swimming allowed in any of the dams.
14. Membership fees applicable (subject to change from time to time) include a joining fee and annual fee. A family package is available on request.
15. The use of open space areas by anglers, including the golf course, is ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK AT ALL TIMES. The Fishing Club shall entertain no claims for damages of whatsoever nature or from whatsoever cause arising.
16. Breach of any of the above rules will be subject to a R500 penalty. Persistent transgressions may result in higher penalties and/or legal action.
