

## Local Rules

### 1. Out of bounds

- All areas demarcated by white stakes, painted white lines, all estate properties, boundary fences and beyond white tipped posts by the 18th green.

### 2. Water Hazards

- Yellow stakes demarcate water hazards.
- Red stakes demarcate lateral water hazards.
- Where yellow or red lines are in existence, they define the margin.
- In order to speed up play a player may play a provisional ball in accordance with rule 27-1 where a ball may be deemed to be lost outside the hazard.

### 3. Protection Of Trees

- If a tree is tagged in green and it interferes with the players intended swing or stance compulsory relief must be taken under rule 24 - 2 (b) - (one club length from the closest point of relief).

### 4. Gardens And Flowerbeds

- All gardens and flowerbeds on the golf course are an integral part of the course.

### 5. Immovable Obstructions

- These include artificial surfaces, roads, cart paths, bridges, all distance markers, sprinkler heads, roped fences within bounds and benches as well as borehole and electrical installations. Relief may be taken for stance or swing interference, but not for line of play purposes.

### 6. Ground Under Repair

- All areas will be clearly demarcated.

## General

1. Players or caddies may not retrieve golf balls from private properties.
2. All distances on the fairway are measured to the front of the green.
3. Sand bags and pitch forks are compulsory.
4. Marshals act on instruction from the golf committee and monitor slow play, dress code and cart use.
5. Plus handicaps +1 on 7th, +2 on 18th, +3 on 4th, +4 on 15th.
