

## FISHING CLUB RULES

The Fishing Club rules shall always comply with and be subject to the Rules of the Silver Lakes Homeowners Association NPC (the HOA), and in the event of any conflict between the Fishing Club rules and the rules of the HOA, the rules of the latter shall prevail.

1. Only residents and/or members of the Golf Club may become members of the Fishing Club.
2. Only paid-up members of the Fishing Club will be allowed to fish on the Estate.
3. Members must carry the membership cards with them when fishing and produce them on request.
4. If members wish to invite visitors to fish, this will be allowed by prior arrangement with the committee, and the visitor must be accompanied by that member at all times.
5. Fishing is only allowed in the following demarcated areas:
  - a. On the dam wall, to the right of the 17<sup>th</sup> fairway, approximately 30m from the 14<sup>th</sup> green, to the end of the wall, opposite the 12<sup>th</sup> green;
  - b. 2. A small (10 – 15m) area behind the 10<sup>th</sup> green;
  - c. A small area (10 – 15m) to the right of the bridge leading to the 9<sup>th</sup> green;
  - d. A 50m strip on the bank of the dam between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> green, opposite the 7<sup>th</sup> green;
  - e. The dam in the nature reserve area (the grass embankment on the South east corner of the dam, near the small inlet); and
  - f. Grassed bank in Game Reserve area near spillway (not in front of any of the houses).
6. Fishing is only permitted between 7:30 until 19:30, Monday to Sunday (including public holidays).
7. All fish, unless hurt, must be released.
8. No person is allowed on the greens or in the bunkers while fishing.
9. The lighting of fires, including gas braai's, will not be allowed while fishing.
10. No camping, overnight camping and/or tents allowed. Only beach umbrellas and open-sided gazebos will be allowed while fishing.
11. No cars are allowed on the golf course.
12. Golf carts are allowed, provided they stick to the rules for golf carts as prescribed by the SLHOA rules.
13. No boating or swimming allowed in any of the dams.
14. Registration fees are subject to change from time to time.
15. The use of open space areas by anglers, including the golf course, is ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK AT ALL TIMES. The Fishing Club shall entertain no claims for damages of whatsoever nature or from whatsoever cause arising.
16. Breach of any of the above rules will be subject to a R500 penalty. Persistent transgressions may result in higher penalties and / or legal action.
